Start

The start will be at the Argoed farm Trefeglwys, SY17 5QT, on the side on the main road along the B4569. Between Trefeglwys and Caersws. Signing on and machine examination from 17:00. First race (fun race) will be 18:15 and will be 30 minutes in duration. Race 2 will be 19:00 and will be 1 hour 15 minutes duration.

Entries

Enter either by Facebook on the Hafren Dirt Bike Club page. Or by phone to the secretary of the meeting. Entries will also be available on the night, but

booking in prior to this is advisable. Cost will be £30 for the fun race and £35 for the main race. One event license included

Route

The course will be set on a large stubble field and will be around 1-2 mile in length. The course will be marked with orange pegs and tape. The novice race will run a shorter lap

Classes

Novice Fun Race (Race 1) – Fun bike 50, 50cc/Auto, 65cc, 85cc, Fun Bike, Open, Trials

Main race (Race 2) - Expert 50cc/Auto, 65cc, Small Wheel 85cc, Big Wheel 85cc, Novice 125cc

We are only running a **novice** 125 class

Capacity for youth machines

Riders aged 14-16 machines must be a minimum of 80cc and a maximum of 150cc (regardless of two or four stroke) and electric bikes upto 10bhp measured at the rear wheel

Riders aged between 12-14 machines must be a minimum of 80cc and a maximum of 85cc (regardless of two or four stroke engine) and electric bikes up to 10bhp measured and the rear wheel.
