# **ANNOUNCEMENT**:

Hafren Dirt Bike Club will hold an open all Terrain Rally event. Held under the ACU National Sporting code, the All Terrain Rally Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and Final Instructions that may be issued.

#### Event:

This is a type of event specifically designed to be suitable for Trail bikes. This event will be decided over a number of "Special Stages" which will be timed to the nearest second. The course is a mixture of open hillside and forest tracks.

# **Eligibility:**

All riders must hold a current ACU National or SACU Licence and be aged 16 years or over. Any rider or passenger from another FMN including the MCUI must produce a licence by their own FMN together with a Start Permission which shows proof of eligibility.

#### **Tvres**

Front and rear tyres must be ROAD LEGAL; tyres which are marked NHU (not for highway use), are specifically excluded. Decision at scrutineers discretion

#### Start/Finish:

Sweet Lamb Rally Complex, Sign posted off the A44, Llangurig to Aberystwyth Road. SY18 6SY

# **Classes**

- Rally Lite 1 2 stroke up to 250cc, 4 stroke up to 350cc
- Rally Lite 2 2 stroke over 250cc, 4 stroke over 350cc
- Big Bike over 575cc single
- Trail Trail bikes as described by the manufacturer
- Twin Twin cylinder machines
- Beginners (1 lap less, running at back of field)

Awards - There will be awards for best Over 40, Over 50, Over 60, Lady

Motocross bikes are not permitted in this event

# **Beginners Class:**

In an effort to attract more newcomers to the sport, we now incorporate a very successful beginner's class in all HDBC Rallies. This will cater for riders on rally, enduro and trail bikes. Riders will have to cover shorter mileage, Usually 2 laps instead of the 3 laps for the other classes, so ideal for those who don't feel capable or are a little unsure about being able to cover the full distance. You will also have slightly more time to complete each lap. All those that group themselves between 8 – 10 on the grading scale on the entry form will automatically be put into the beginners class.

# **Entries:**

Entry fees of £90 will not be returned unless the event is cancelled or the rider gives a valid reason, i.e. Doctor's note, at least 7 days prior to the event. In such cases £10 will be deducted to cover costs. Entries to be completed ONLINE ONLY, using the ACU system, (Follow link from website) ensure your email address is correct as this will be used for final instructions etc, Entries close 10<sup>th</sup> October or when full (180 Riders).

# NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

To compete, an ACU licence is required. A one event licence can be purchased with your entry. You must produce your licence at signing on, if you fail to do so you will be required to purchase a one event licence at the charge of £15.

#### Results:

Results will be available at <a href="https://www.hafrendbc.co.uk">www.hafrendbc.co.uk</a>, and sent out via email. No results will be sent via post.

#### **Rules/Penalties**

If a Red Flag is shown all riders must stop immediately and seek advice from the official showing the flag. A yellow flag indicates that all riders must proceed with GREAT CAUTION. There will be an overall average speed of 18 mph. There will be no penalty for being late at a "Special Stage" until you are more than 30 minutes late, at which point you will be excluded.

#### **Ridina Numbers**

Numbers & Backing will be provided by the organisers and MUST be used

#### Refuelling

Refuelling will only be permitted in the designated area at the Start/Finish, and entrants must therefore ensure that their machines are capable of completing a 50 mile lap on a tank of fuel.

# Clothing

Helmets must have an ACU gold or silver stamp. It is strongly recommended that Enduro type clothing (Inc jacket) and boots are worn.

# **Machine Examination/Signing On**

Signing on will take place between 18:30 & 20:00 on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> October at the Social and between and 07.30 & 09.00 Sunday 16th October at the start.

Machine examinations will take place on Sunday 16th October ONLY at the start.

This will be confirmed in your final instructions

#### YOU MUST SIGN ON BEFORE YOU CAN SCRUITINEER YOUR BIKE

#### **Noise Meter**

A Noise meter will be present throughout the event. ALL bikes to comply to Sound Control Regulations set out in the ACU Handbook

# STRICTLY NO NOISEY BIKES WILL START THE EVENT

# **Start Time**

The first three riders will start at approximately 9.00 with the rest at twenty second intervals. However this will be confirmed in your final instructions. Starting order will be worked out based upon the ability grading on the entry. You will be asked to grade yourself between 1 and 10, with 1 being an Expert, and 10 being a total beginner. This will hopefully mean riders will be riding with others of similar ability.

There will be an opportunity to add a ride near request when you complete your entry, bear in mind you will be grouped at the at the position of the lowest ability rider in your group.
